Dear IRP Registrants:

To continue to ensure compliance with the <u>Timely Collection of Apportionable Fees</u> as outlined in <u>Article X, Section 1210</u>, of the International Registration Plan, effective April 1, 2020, the Georgia jurisdiction will require full payment of Apportionable Fees prior to issuing a TA/TEAR for Temporary Evidence of Apportioned Registration.

This change will help negate fraudulent activity and reduce the labor cost associated with the timely collection of fees. The Temporary Evidence of Apportioned Registration may be issued at the discretion of the base jurisdiction, please see Article VI, Section 620, Temporary Evidence of Apportioned Registration for reference.

This action ensures that a Registrant remits all the Apportionable Fees owed under the plan in a timely manner and provides the necessary safeguards for revenues of all Member Jurisdictions.

Upon full payment of the invoice a TA/TEAR and Cab Card will be immediately available to the registrant electronically via their email address.

Additionally, as a reminder, Temporary Evidence of Apportioned Registration will not be issued at the time of renewal.
