



## INSTRUCTIONS How to complete the MV-30 Form

### PURPOSE of this AFFIDAVIT

This affidavit is to be used by Georgia Veterans who are seeking relief from state and local title ad valorem taxes.

### COMPLETING this AFFIDAVIT

- Check the Georgia Veteran's exemption that applies to the applicant.
- Record the VIN, year, make and model of the vehicle to be exempted from Title Ad Valorem Tax.
- Complete the vehicle owner's information. The mailing address block should contain the physical address of the owner.
- Certify all statements are true and accurate. Sign, date and record the vehicle owner's driver's license.

### REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Submit all required documents along with this affidavit. Use the provided checklist below to make sure all documents are submitted.

This completed affidavit, legibly printed or typed, must be submitted along with all required documents to your local county tag office. Any alteration or correction voids this affidavit. County Tag Agent shall retain this affidavit for audit purposes.
