

WHAT IS DRIVES?

The Georgia Department of Revenue (DOR) and the Georgia Department of Driver Services (DDS) are collaborating on a Request for Proposal (RFP) to modernize the Tag & Title system (GRATIS) as well as the Driver's License system (DDLS).

WHY IS DRIVES NECESSARY?

The GRATIS and DDLS systems are being replaced because they are mainframe-based. The technology they are based on is in decline and expensive to maintain.

STATUS:

- The RFP is still ongoing. The State of Georgia is doing its due diligence prior to selecting a winning vendor for the RFP. Site visits for prospective bidders occurred during the month of May.
- Once a vendor is selected, DRIVES team members will be working together at the DOR Century Center building. Team members will include DOR, DDS, county tag office and vendor personnel.
- ◆ The DRIVES Data project team is working on ways to clean up data in the GRATIS system. The team has already identified changes to the official data retention schedule, and is working on processes to eliminate duplicate data within GRATIS.
